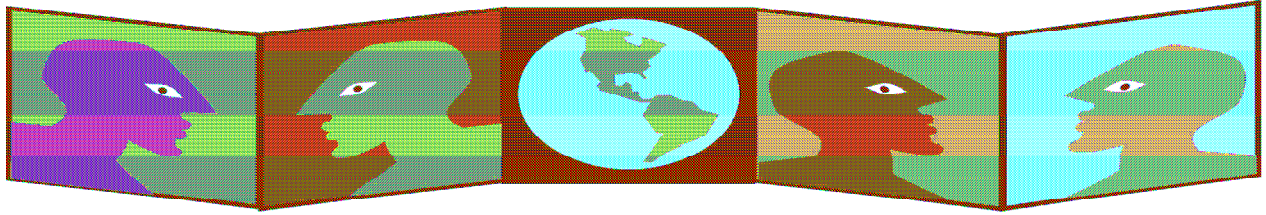

Day of 1,000 Volunteers-2008, our third annual event, is a demonstration of how our community can come together around a shared vision of success for one glorious day of service. Partners will then reconvene throughout the following year, on a smaller scale, to leverage the relationships begun on that day and continue serving our community with shared and leveraged resources.

Volunteers who contribute to this day will be invited back to engage in long-term projects such as mentoring or tutoring or ongoing environmental activities and other programs. Schools, student groups, businesses, community organizations, church members and individuals can join the effort as it continues and grows into future events and programs.

WHY: ***Inform youth and adults on the issue of the environment and engage them in fun, sustainable activities!***

WHAT & WHEN Saturday April 26, between 8am and 2pm, 1,000 volunteers will perform volunteer service projects across greater Pasadena on public school campuses, at youth serving organizations and in public spaces. People from all walks of life will contribute time and resources to benefit our environment and humanity.

Five hundred students and 500 adult volunteers will engage in impactful, demonstration projects in areas such as environmental education and action, planting trees and organic gardens, starting or enhancing recycling programs to reduce, reuse and recycle products, and more! Youth and adults will work hand-in-hand as we learn to better serve our planet and ourselves. We may even launch one or two student-run businesses! As always, our plan is to show volunteers such a good time that they will then engage in longer-term volunteer opportunities on their own or through our Service Learning initiatives where service projects are used to make academics come alive!
